

Canadian artist **Jane Tingley** will travel to Ljubjana, Slovenia to present her work *Peripheral Response* at *Festival Break 2.3, 8 th International Festival of Independent Artists*.

This eighth edition of the festival provides fertile ground for young, emerging artists and opens its doors to all new forms of artistic exploration.

Other artistic disciplines represented at this event include comic strips, photography, interactive projects, interdisciplinary arts, documentaries, animated films, architecture, installations, performances and media arts. The theme being explored this year is *New Species*.

Peripheral Response is an interactive environment that invokes the body's peripheral nervous system as a launching pad for exploration and the search for understanding. The installation locates the spectator in the mystery of flesh and focuses on the action by which the two systems negotiate one another. The resulting system of exchange is a physical encounter, where viewers' body becomes guest. As one moves through the space, the ripple effect caused by its presence calms and the installation settles. ***Peripheral Response*** received production support by Molior. Jane Tingley seeks to create installations by employing both old and new technologies to explore emotion and experience. Her work is based on an exploration of epidermal space, where information escapes in fragments via biological systems, which metamorphose through chemical, electrical, and mechanical articulations. Jane is interested in the collaborative and creative actions involved with "seeking to understand" as systems merge into each other, invent each other and communicate, from the microcosm of the body to macrocosm of the living world.
